Contest Rules

1. A division may be combined with another if an insufficient number of couples have failed to register.
2. Each couple will perform one dance. Couples are responsible for bringing their music to the registration table by 3 p.m. Contestant's music must be labeled with name.
3. Attendance by at least one of the competing partners is mandatory at the contestant's meeting held at 3 p.m. Rules, regulations and questions will be addressed at this time
4. The order of dance will be determined by drawing prior to the competition at the contestants meeting at 3 PM.
5. Each couple will consist of one male and one female.
6. Couples will be judged based on the following categories: Execution, togetherness, repertoire, smoothness and degree of difficulty.
7. Scoring will be on a relative placement system.
8. Any contest rulings will be governed by a majority vote of the Shag Contest Committee and the Judges. Rulings will be final.
9. The deadline for guarantee entry is April 28, 2008.

ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED THE DAY OF THE COMPETITION.

10. All decisions of the judging panel are final.
11. Awards will be cash prizes paid out to the 6th place in all divisions.
